- Founded on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 1905, more than 100 years ago
- Only university in Atlantic Canada specializing in agricultural science
- NSAC is one of the oldest centres for agricultural education and research in Canada
- Eighty-seven per cent of NSAC graduates are living in and contributing to the success of Atlantic Canada
- NSAC delivers a 12:1 student-to-faculty ratio which means more individualized support and more customized teaching and learning
- NSAC faculty are highly educated and nationally and internationally networked
- NSAC is home to the \$9.8 million Atlantic Poultry Research Centre, opened May 2007
- NSAC is the proud host of the 2008 CCAA Women's National Basketball Championships, March 14-16
- Dr. Rob Gordon, NSAC Dean of Research, is a 2007 recipient of the Premier's Award of Excellence
