Supporting Documents:

1. Transcripts - Once you have submitted your application, arrangements must be made to have official transcripts forwarded from **all** previously attended secondary and post-secondary educational institutions. **An official transcript is one that has been forwarded directly to the NSAC Registrar's Office from the issuing institution;** photocopied documents are not acceptable. High school attendees must arrange with their school to have mid-term marks forwarded, and then final results as soon as they become available. Transcripts not in English should include an English translation.

2. English Testing - If English is not your native language, you must provide official results from **one** of the following standardized tests:

TOEFL - a minimum score of 550 OR iBTs minimum score of 80

MELAB - a minimum score of 80

IELTS - a minimum score of 6.0 is required

*Students who meet all admission requirements except for the English Testing levels may be conditionally accepted to the NSAC subject to completion of an English and Academic Bridging Program. Please contact the NSAC for more information.

Documents submitted to the Nova Scotia Agricultural College become the property of the College. Neither originals nor copies will be released to the applicant or anyone outside the University. Applications, transcripts and other supporting documents of applicants who are not admitted or who do not attend may be destroyed at the discretion of the Registry. If an applicant wishes to reapply, a new set of documents may be required.

B.Sc. (Agr.) and Pre-Veterinary Medicine - High school graduation & 70% avg. in five Gr.12 university prep. courses: English, Pre-Calculus Math (or 70% in Acad. Math), one elective, any two of: Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Geology, Oceans, Agriculture

Bachelor of Technology

Environmental Horticulture - completion of Environmental Horticulture Technology Diploma or equivalent

Applied Science—High school graduation & 70% avg. in five Gr.12 university prep. courses: English, Pre-Calculus Math (or 70% in Acad. Math), Physics, any two other electives, Preferably Chemistry and Biology.

Bachelor of Administration

International Food Business - High school graduation & 75% avg. in five Gr.12 university prep. courses, incl. English, Math; letter of intent; personal interview

Engineering - High school graduation & 70% avg. in five Gr.12 university prep. courses: English, Pre-Calculus Math (or 70% in Acad. Math), Chemistry, Physics, one elective

Technology Diploma
